ABSTRACT SUBMISSIONS:

- 300–600-word abstract outlining the content of the proposed presentation.
- Speaker's bio and current image (300 dpi jpeg) must accompany the submission.
- Outline to state clearly and in some detail what the presentation will contain, including a summary of the results and conclusion of the work described.
- Please use the Abstract Templates provided.

SPEAKERS' PRESENTATIONS:

- Sessions will be presented via Zoom meeting.
- Presentation will be pre-recorded and reviewed by the Appita Technical Committee for approval.
- Each session will comprise three presentations.
- Presentation timing:
 - 5-minute chair introduction, strictly 15 minutes speaker presentation (pre-recorded), 10-minute virtual Q&A.
- Speakers are expected to join the session at 11:30 am (AEST) for speakers prep and tech test.
