## 7:30 Geo40 - from Shipping Container to World First Plant Mary Helliwell & Rachel Grobecker, Geo40

The presentation will cover the journey from concept to commercialisation of Geo40's silica recovery technology. This includes the challenges of developing a mineral recovery process in a geothermal environment and the opportunities it presents for the geothermal operators. Finally, it will touch on the market for recovered silica and how it could have a major positive impact on the environment.
