Direct Analysis in Real Time Mass Spectrometry (DART-MS) is a powerful and rapid tool for wood species identification and could support combating illegal logging and ensuring quality control for exports.

This technology can assess timber quality and wood properties by analyzing chemical composition, leading to optimized processing and better prediction of wood performance. Its key advantages — speed, minimal sample preparation, and versatility—make it a game-changer for a more efficient and sustainable forestry sector.
