Dr Bing Song, Scientist - Chemistry and Physics - Sustainable

In this presentation, Bing Song will selectively introduce some of Scion's recent efforts in solid biofuels production including (1) co-densification of forest residues and waste thermoplastic, (2) the swelling behaviour of biomass briquettes, (3) heterodox torrefaction of forest residues, (4) binderless densification of torrefied biomass, and (5) continuous briquetting. Finally, we will briefly share our collaboration story with Museum of Transport and Technology (MOTAT) on establishing a demonstrational trial of using New Zealand's forest residues as a solid biofuel for powering a steam tram.
